

St Andrew's Church Restoration



A church has been on the present site since 1319 and next year will be the 700th anniversary.

January has seen work commencing to repair and replace stone work on the East window above the Nave of the church.

Scaffolding will be in place for some two months, with all the plain glass being removed and cleaned during the process.

Similar work will then take place on the West window, replacing parts of the external stone window frames.

Attention will then turn to the internal walls which have damaged plaster due to time. Removal of all the damaged wall plaster within the church and redecorate throughout.

Not that much has changed over the last 110 years, the enclosed image from around 1909
